



Meeting Room Policy

The Meeting Rooms of the Schenectady County Public Library are available for a variety of social, cultural and educational activities and discussions of current public questions. They are available on equal terms to all groups in the community, regardless of beliefs and affiliations of their members, provided that the meetings are open to the public. No charge shall be made for admission to any meeting and no collection shall be taken up; neither may dues be collected. Use of these rooms is limited to **three** meetings per calendar year for any organization. Events cannot be scheduled more than **two months** in advance of the meeting date.
