



Library Rules

Use of the library is for reading, studying and learning.

Violation of library rules may result in loss of library privileges, including being banned from the premises.

The following are **NOT** permitted:

- Any behavior that interferes with the peaceful enjoyment of the library
- Unsupervised children under age 10
- Any behavior that creates health or environmental hazards
- Computer use in violation of policy
- Profanity
- Food or drink
- Sleeping
- Bathing
- Animals
- Bicycles

The following acts constitute violations against the County and are subject to legal action and/or loss of library privileges, including being banned from the premises:

- Loitering, soliciting or panhandling on library property
- Public intoxication
- Harassment of or threats to library staff or patron
- Use of tobacco products
- To sequester or “stash” library property within the library building for the exclusive use of an individual or group
- To deface, mutilate or otherwise damage library property
- To remove or attempt to remove library property from the library without proper authorization
- To steal or knowingly possess stolen library property
- To traffic, for profit or otherwise, in library property
- To use library property or materials, including computers or wireless network, to commit a crime
- To refuse to show identification upon request of library staff or security officer
- To be in non-public areas without authorization or in library facilities after closing hours
